As global forces increasingly shape local outcomes, Atlanta's leaders must be prepared to operate in an interconnected world. In response, the World Affairs Council of Atlanta launched the Global Leadership Fellows, a selective, cohort-based leadership development program for early-career professionals.

The program cultivates globally fluent, cross-sector leaders positioned to shape Atlanta's future across business, government, civil society, and the nonprofit industries. Fellows are selected from diverse professional backgrounds and bring 5–15 years of experience to a 10-month learning experience grounded in real-world exposure and applied leadership.

Through a structured series of Master Classes, leadership coaching, and an international immersion, the Global Leadership Fellows program prioritizes direct engagement with decision-makers, institutions, and global challenges. Fellows gain practical insight into how global systems function and how leadership decisions are made—emerging better equipped to navigate complexity, build relationships and contribute to Atlanta's civic, economic, and professional landscape.

### Program Highlights

#### Dynamic Master Classes

Six immersive, full-day themed programs during which Fellows gain first-hand exposure to international ecosystems that fuel Atlanta. This experiential learning includes high-level dialogue with senior executives, subject matter experts, distinguished diplomats and dignitaries, and exclusive behind-the-scenes tours of key Atlanta organizations.

#### Professional Coaching

Leadership growth is intentionally woven throughout the program. Fellows engage in facilitated leadership development sessions and coaching conversations that focus on Strategic thinking and decision-making, leading across difference and complexity, communication, negotiation, and influence, and values-based leadership in global contexts

#### International Immersion

The program features a week-long international immersion, where Fellows explore global systems firsthand through site visits, expert briefings, and cross-sector engagement. The immersion reinforces learning from the Master Classes while expanding Fellows' global perspective through direct experience.

### Organizational Value, Importance, and Prestige of Participation

The Global Leadership Fellows program is a prestigious opportunity for employees to grow their leadership capabilities, gain a global perspective, and build high-value networks. Departmental teams and whole organizations benefit from employees' personal and professional development.

Gaining insights into international best practices and strategies by engaging with experts from diverse backgrounds and industries.
