Supervisor Approval Fellows must provide written and signed approval from their supervisors regarding the program's time commitment, events, activities, and schedule.

Passport

Applicants must ensure their passport is valid for at least six months beyond the date of the international study tour.

 - 5. Time Commitment: How will you manage your time and commitments to fully participate and engage in this program?
 - 6. Is there any additional information that you believe would assist the Selection Committee in assessing your qualifications for this opportunity?
 - Two Letters of Recommendation: (Not from family or friends) We value recommendation letters that provide a detailed and personalized assessment of an applicant's professional skills, character, and potential for leadership impact within the Global Leadership Fellows program.
